RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

I Have A Chance Support Services Ltd. has several homes that provide around the clock care based in the town of Stony Plain and in rural Parkland County. Individuals are placed based on their level of care requirements. All homes have their own vehicles for Support Workers to transport individuals to appointments, recreational and leisure activities and provide transport for guests.





RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM (LIFE SKILLS)

Our Support Workers assist individuals in our care with the following:

- Planning and preparing well-balanced meals
- Determining grocery needs and shopping within a budget
- Washing dishes
- Vacuuming, sweeping, and mopping
- Cleaning bathrooms
- Completing laundry
- Yard maintenance

DAY OPTIONS PROGRAM



- <u>Social Inclusion</u> (access to support network, identification with a community, ability to participate in desired social and community activities)

Spruce Grove and Stony Plain offer access to a range of health and medical services including:

The Westview Health Centre, in Stony Plain offers hospital services and counseling for mental health needs.

The City of Edmonton, 15 minutes west of Spruce Grove offers an extended access to health and medical services including specialists, surgeons, assistive technology, Alberta Hospital Edmonton (Psychiatric facility), and many major hospitals.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

The communities of Stony Plain and Spruce Grove offer many spiritual, educational and recreational/leisure opportunities for individuals to become involved in.

Individuals of varying denominations and spiritual beliefs may choose to participate in services at local Catholic, Evangelical Free, Christian Reformed, Christian Fellowship, Lutheran, Evangelical Lutheran, Alliance, Baha'l, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, United, Anglican, Baptist, Bethel Apostic, Bible and Community Churches.

Educational opportunities are available straight through academic upgrading and college. Individuals may also chose to attend special interest classes including Hip Hop dancing, computers, martial arts, fitness, music, arts and so on, or check out local libraries.
